

## iPad - Turning on Automatic Updates

### 1. Turn on automatic updates (optional)



#### Keep Your iPad Up to Date

Get the latest features, security, and improvements by updating iOS automatically.

You will receive a notification before updates are installed, and can choose other options in Settings.

Continue

Your iPad will automatically install updates.

a) Tap 'Continue'.

### 2. Set up Location Services (optional)

#### Location Services

Location Services allows Maps and other apps and services like Find My to gather and use data indicating your approximate location.

### 3. Set up Apple Pay (optional)

Apple pay enables you to save your card details to send money to friends and to make secure purchases in apps and on the web.

**4. Set up Apple Keychain (optional)**

**iCloud Keychain**

Keep the passwords and credit card information you save secure and up to date on the devices you approve.

The information in your keychain is encrypted and cannot be read by Apple.

iCloud Keychain securely stores passwords and credit card information on your iPad.

**5. Set up Siri (optional)**



**Siri**

Siri helps you get things done just by asking. Siri can even make suggestions before you ask in apps, and keyboards.

To use Siri, press and hold the side button or say "Hey Siri" anytime.

Apple stores transcripts of your interactions with Siri and may review a subset of these transcripts. Siri also sends information like your voice input, Hey Siri setup, contacts, and location to Apple to process your request. Data is not associated with your Apple ID. [About Siri...](#)

Siri enables you to communicate with your phone by talking to it and asking it questions.

To set up Siri, **tap 'Continue'.**

Otherwise, **tap 'Set Up Later in Settings'.**

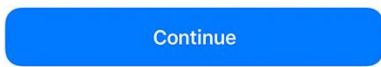
**Say "Hey Siri" into your iPad**

a) **Say** the words in quotation marks out loud.

## “Hey Siri” is Ready

Siri will recognise your voice whenever you say, “Hey Siri”.

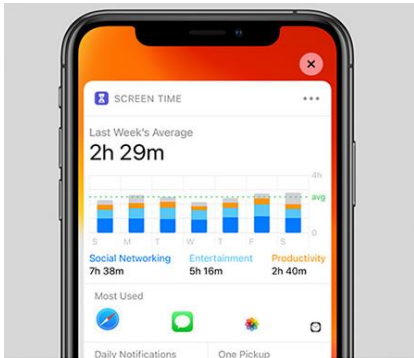
Tap Continue to finish setting up your iPad.



Siri has now been set up.

b) Tap ‘Continue’.

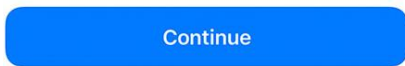
## 6. Set up Screen Time (optional)



Screen Time will provide you with a report on how much time you spend on your iPad. It also lets you set time limits for daily app use.

## Screen Time

Get a weekly report with insights about your screen time and set time limits for apps you want to manage. You can also use Screen Time on children’s devices and set up parental controls.

**7. Set up App Analytics (optional)**

**App Analytics**

Help app developers improve their apps by choosing to share app activity and crash data with them through Apple. You can change your decision later in Settings.
